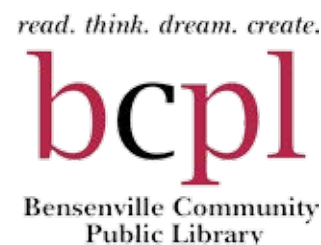
Harry Potter Festival - Saturday, October 15
